“A black-clad figure which seemed to have ascended from Hades” is how Heinrich Heine described Italian violin virtuoso Niccolò Paganini. As a sickly four-year-old he was thought dead, wrapped in a shroud and almost buried alive. By 16, he had to pawn his violin to cover his gambling losses.

The second violin concerto, called ‘La Campanella’, composed by Niccolò Paganini at the peak of his career, is just one of the 26 works, almost 80 tracks, included in this unique compilation of 8 hours of great music from the Classical Period.
